Our topic for this term:

In the first half term, children will learn about: evacuation, rationing, The Blitz and how propaganda played a part in motivating. The art topic will see the children making model Anderson Shelters. Perhaps they can begin to think about resources they can bring into school to help with their designs.

To tie in with our topic, our English lessons will be centred around the novel 'Carrie's War', which is how two children were affected by evacuation during World War II. This will give us an opportunity to explore a range of writing genres.

Science:

Our science topic this half term is 'Light'. This will focus on themes such as reflection, refraction and the spectrum. Children will also be given the opportunity to create their own periscope.
