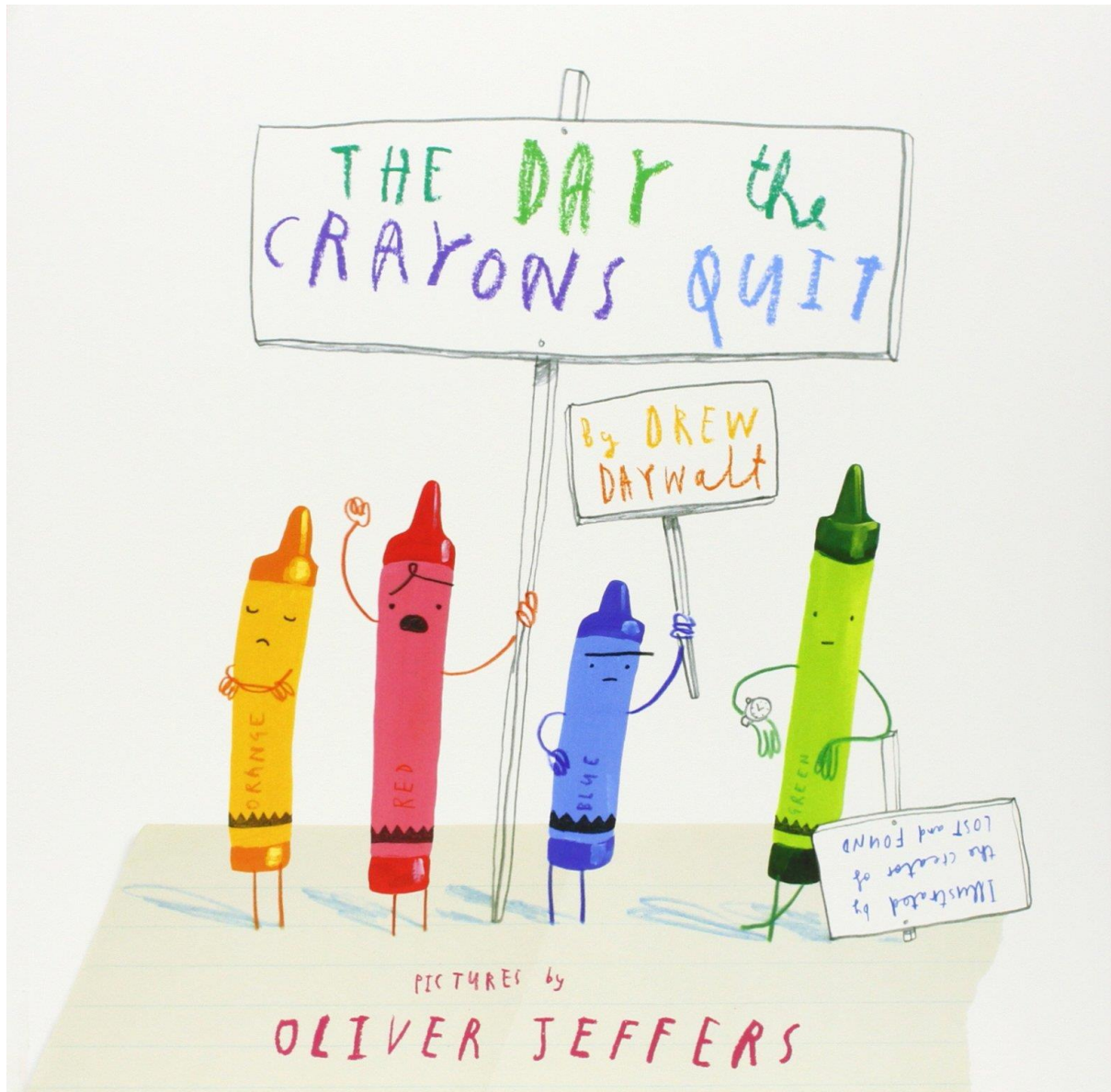


Welcome to Key Stage 1
