# EYFS

## Topic: The Gunpowder Plot/ Fireworks

### Activities your child will be accessing

- Talking about being safe and who to call if there is a fire
- Building bonfires using construction materials
- Making firework pictures on the Paint computer program
- Talk about day and night

### Nursery Maths

We will be focusing on recognizing shapes such as circle, square, triangle and rectangle. We will be looking at different patterns we can make with them as well as counting the number of sides and corners.

We will also be recognising numbers and numicon to ten.

### Nursery Phonics

We will be investigating the sounds we can make with our bodies e.g. clapping and stamping. We will also be copying rhythms.

### Reception Maths

We will be focusing on number recognition, counting objects with 1-1 correspondence, learning about 2D shapes and adding numbers together using the numicon to help.

### Reception Phonics

Over the next two weeks we will be coming to the end of the Phase 2 Letters and Sounds programme and we will have learnt all of the sounds. We will be focusing on segmenting and blending and also correct letter formation.

### PE

In PE the children are focusing on Multiskills, Activities will include basic movements, spatial awareness and movement with a ball.
