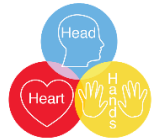

Spring	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Traditional French food.</li> <li>- How do French people celebrate birthdays?</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Say different foods.</li> <li>- Say different drinks.</li> <li>- Ask when someone's birthday is.</li> <li>- Sing the birthday song.</li> <li>- Respond to someone asking when their birthday is.</li> <li>- Ask for a type of food or drink</li> <li>- Respond to a waiter or waitress.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Read menus</li> <li>- Read short passages involving food</li> <li>- Read months of the years in the context of birthdays.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Write a party menu.</li> <li>- Write simple opinions about food.</li> <li>- Use dictionaries to find out new foods and drinks.</li> </ul>



<b>Summer</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- France's day of independence is called Bastille Day and is a big celebration in France.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Say different family members.</li> <li>- Describe people using colours.               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Say different clothes</li> </ul> </li> <li>- Describe clothes using colours.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Read descriptions about people, including what they wear.               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Read family trees.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Write descriptions about families, including what they wear.               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Create a family tree</li> </ul> </li> <li>- Use dictionaries to find more words for specific clothes items or for descriptive words.</li> </ul>
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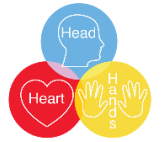
**Y5/6 Crucial Knowledge Cycle A**

Culture:
