

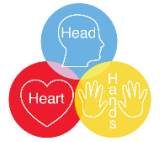

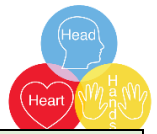

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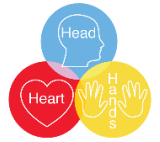

UTW – Science	Minibeasts Plants - growth Seasonal Changes	Minibeasts are invertebrates – they are creatures without backbones Minibeasts need food, water and shelter to survive Minibeasts live in micro habitats Explore the world around us (4 seasons,) In Spring, new life grows. It stays lighter for longer during the spring months. Spring months are March, April and May.
