





Stone Age!







This half term, our main focus of our learning is around our **History** topic of 'The Stone Age'.

By the end of this unit, we will have developed our understanding of what the Stone Age was, who the Stone Age people were, when the Stone Age happened and the impact the Stone Age had on future Britain.

Additionally, we will have also created our own diary entry pretending to be the main character from the 'Stone Age boy'.

English -

In lessons, we will be using the book 'Stone Age Boy' to continue to inspire our writing.

This book is about a boy who trips and falls into the Stone Age! He learns all about the Stone Age way of life.

We will continue to work on our diary entry, focusing on our 1st person and past tense skills as well as our diary specific skills.

In this unit of work, we will be focusing on newspaper articles, whereby we will be developing our knowledge of:

- The features of a newspaper
- Newspapers are a type of recount
- Sequencing of events.
- Viewpoints
- Conjunctions to express time, place and cause
- Inverted commas for speech
- Use of paragraphs to organise ideas
- Expanded noun phrases
- Fronted adverbials
- Apostrophes for possession



Maths-

In lessons, we will be focussing on the topics of:

Addition and Subtraction:

- Recognise the addition and subtraction sign.
- Use a column method with and without exchanging.
- Use mental stratergies.
- Understand when a word problem is asking you to add or subtract.

Multiplication and Division

- Understand the multiply and divide sign.
- Understand and use the column and short division methods.
- Recognise times table patterns.
- Recognise when a word problem is asking for multiplication and division.

Science-

In lessons, we will be focusing on the topic of **Animals including Humans:**

- Animals including humans need the correct amount and type of nutrition.
- They cannot make their own food they must hunt, cook or prepare food.
- They need a skeleton for support, movement and protection.

Computing

In lessons, we will be focusing E-Safety. This half term we will learn how to stay safe online by recognising what cyber bullying is and how to deal with situations that arise online. We will also learn all about the importance of keeping our personal information private online!



<u>DT</u>

In lessons, we will be focussing on food hygiene, how to safely prepare a meal and a healthy diet. We will finish this unit by creating our own festive European sandwich using all of the things we have learnt.

Art

In lessons, we will be focusing on the skill of drawing. We will work towards creating our own final piece of Stone Age cave drawings.
