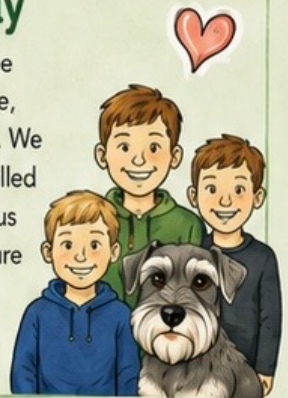
Why I Love Key Stage 2

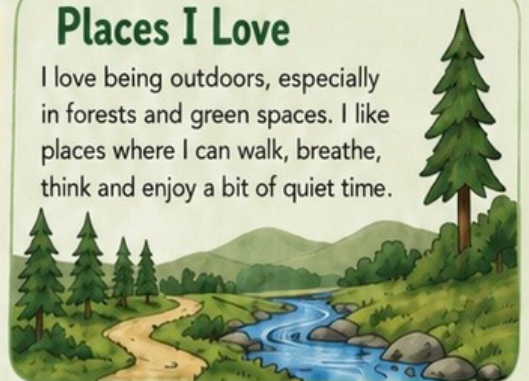
Favourite Food
