Dress Code

Uniform:

- White shirt and tie
- Dark Blue sweat shirts or cardigans
- Trousers/Skirts: black or dark grey
- Black shoes and Grey, Black or white socks
- Hats can be worn when the weather is cold or it is sunny, these items are to be worn outside of the school only
- Blue and white gingham dresses may also be worn as can black/dark grey pinafore dresses with an appropriate school jumper or cardigan.



For children with long hair, it is expected that hair is tied back or fastened up with an appropriate, sensible hair bobble or band. (No large bows e.g. JoJo Bow)

Please Note:

If for any reason your child does not have appropriate school shoes a note needs to be sent in with the child explaining the reasons. Inappropriate foot ware will be allowed for the remainder of that week.

Jewellery:

- One watch
- Stud ear rings, one stud in each ear only
- Any Jewellery which is directly linked to religious affiliations

Pupils should not wear rings, hoop ear rings or any other form of jewellery. This is for health and safety reasons. All jewellery must be removed for P.E sessions, including ear rings. This is to be done before school or by the child in school.

If it is noted that pupils are wearing any other type of jewellery they will be asked to remove it and give it to their class teacher. It will be returned to them at the end of the day.

P.E Kit:

- T-shirt or polo shirt (white)
- Shorts (black or dark blue)
- Pumps for indoor P.E (although children can participate indoors in bare feet)
- Trainers for outside use
- Jogging trousers (blue or black) and an extra top layer (not school jumper) for outdoor P.E during the winter.

P.E kit should be in school every day and should be taken home and washed on a regular basis.

Hairstyles should be of a sensible nature, no stripes, symbols or initials to be cut into the hair and no unnatural hair colours. If a child comes to school with an inappropriate hairstyle, parents will be contacted and asked if there is a quick way the issue could be resolved. If there is no quick way the child will be educated away from class until the hairstyle is once again acceptable.
