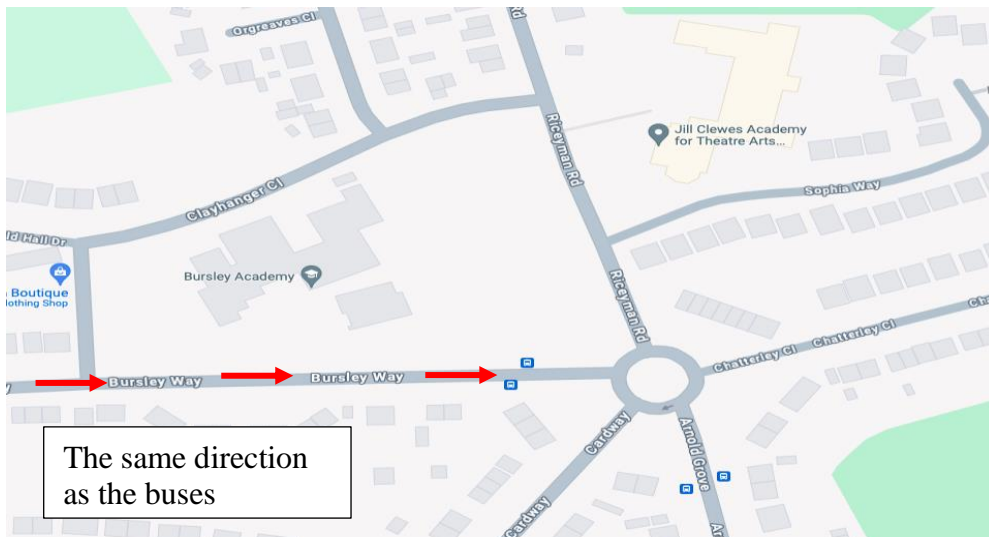
Dear Parents/Carers

We have had numerous emails and telephone calls regarding **dangerous driving** and **parking around our school**.

We are sure that you will agree, the **safety of all of our children is paramount** and therefore we need to **work together to safeguard our children**.

These are our actions to address this situation:

1. We would like parents to consider **following a one way system** around our school to try and alleviate the congestion at drop off and pick up times. We would really appreciate your support in this as we cannot solve this on our own.



2. We have **ordered banners/signs for the school railings** to try and highlight the dangers and prevent parents/carers mounting the pavements to park, or stopping in the road to drop off or pick up children.
3. We have **rang the Staffordshire County Council Local Highways Department** to discuss our concerns and to share those of our parents'.
4. We request that you **use the Jill Clewes car park** instead of parking on the surrounding roads.
5. **Walking to school:** Walk to School Week (Mon 20th to Fri 24th May)
In May 2024 it's National Walking Month - a great time to start your walking to school journey!
6. From Monday 6th May, we have been informed that there will be gas works carried out on Riceyman Road for at least 5 weeks. There will be a 3-way traffic light system along Riceyman Road which will move along in stages once each section has been completed. It is advisable to give yourself plenty of time in setting out for school drop off and pick-ups and be extra cautious and vigilant when driving and walking around our school
